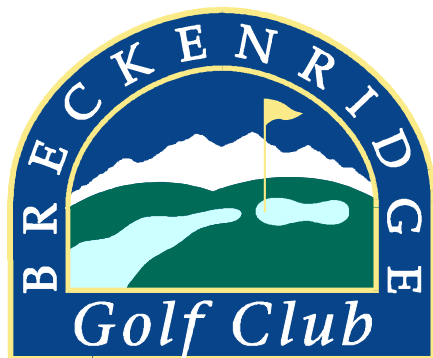
- The Women's Club schedule is comprised of different events from individual, two person, and four person team events. The goal each year is to create a competitive, equitable, and enjoyable club. Each year we add / delete events to keep the schedule fresh. This year the primary change relates to booking tee times. **Tee time requests will be accepted one week in advance. Requests can be made for time periods between; 10-11 or 11-12. The golf operations staff will conduct a lottery and issue tee times on the Saturday prior to the next event. You may or may not be assigned a tee time within your requested block based on demand and past tee time allocation. This will replace the previous phone call method.**
- Ladies Club members are able to choose their teams and pairings to allow players to play with their friends. If you are a member that does not have a team or a group to play with, our staff will help you find a good pairing. We hope all members will be open to playing with new players throughout the year to get to know other golfers and create new friendships. Staff will set up pairings for the Club Championship and certain events TBD.
- The new USGA Local Rule for a ball accidentally moved on the putting green will be in effect for all events.

- 2020 dues are \$80 which includes USGA handicap.
- *In the spirit of the game, all players are asked to read and abide by the rules book. Please help educate your fellow golfers so that all players can enjoy the events.*
- *Per USGA guidelines a maximum home course handicap of 40 will be allowed for tournament play.*
- There is a \$5 weekly entry fee for each event. Prize money is in the form of gift certificates for pro shop merchandise.
- Green fees or passes / cards are required for weekly play.

EVENT FORMATS

MAY 26 - BETTER BALL OF BLIND PARTNERS

- After all players have teed off, the golf shop staff will draw two person teams. The winners will be determined by scoring the best net ball per hole of the partners.
- 100% of handicap will be used

JUNE 2 - LOW GROSS/LOW NET

- Full handicap for the net division
- Players may only place in one division
- 100% of handicap will be used

JUNE 9 - TWO PERSON SCRAMBLE

- Two Person Event
- Each players drive must be used at least **THREE** times
- 25% of combined handicap will be used

JUNE 16 - CHA, CHA, CHA

- Four person event
- The staff will assign teams based on handicaps
- Scoring will be on a net basis for 18 holes. 1 best ball will count on the 1st hole, 2 on the 2nd hole and 3 on the 3rd. 1 score on the 4th, 2 on the 5th and so on
- 100 % of handicap will be used

JUNE 23- INDIVIDUAL STABLEFORD

- 100% of handicap will be used – Points are scored on a net basis

Double Eagle	= 5	Eagle	= 4
Birdie	= 3	Par	= 2
Bogey	= 1	Double bogey or more	= 0

JUNE 30- TWO NET BEST BALLS OF THE FOURSOME

- Scoring will be on a net basis
- Record the two net best balls of the foursome
- 75% of handicap will be used

JULY 7 - TRIPLE PLAY

- Two person event – partner required
- Holes 1-6 will be best ball, holes 7-12 will be modified scotch, and holes 13-18 will be scramble.
- 25% of combined handicap will be used

JULY 14 - ODDS & EVENS

- Four person event
- 1 best net ball will be counted on the odd numbered holes and 2 best net balls will be counted on the even numbered holes.
- 75% of handicap will be used

JULY 21 - CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

TO BE ELIGIBLE YOU MUST HAVE PLAYED IN AT LEAST TWO REGULAR SEASON EVENTS OR BEEN A MEMBER IN 2019. THIS YEARS CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP IS A 18 HOLE EVENT OVER ONE WEEK. WE WILL HAVE A GROSS AND NET DIVISION. TROPHIES WILL BE AWARDED TO FIRST AND SECOND PLACE FINISHERS

JULY 28 - TWO PERSON STABLEFORD

- One best net point per hole will be used for the team score
- 100% of handicap will be used
 - Double eagle = 5
 - Eagle = 4
 - Birdie = 3
 - Par = 2
 - Bogey = 1
 - Double bogey or more = 0

AUG 4 - THREE, TWO, ONE

- The staff will assign teams based on handicaps
- A four person team will count three net best balls on the par threes, two net best balls on the par fours and one net best ball on the par fives

AUG 11 - BETTER BALL OF PARTNERS

- Two players are a team. Handicaps are applied on the appropriate holes. The team will have a net better ball on each hole, which will be recorded as the team score.
- 75% of handicap will be used.

AUG 18 - TWO PERSON SHAMBLE

- Both players will tee off and play from the drive of choice
- Players then play their own ball for the remainder of the hole
- One best net ball will be scored
- 50% of handicap will be used

AUG 25 – PINK BALL - 9 HOLES ONLY

- A four person team will alternate hole by hole who uses the “pink” ball
- Teams will count two Net scores per hole: “pink” ball + lowest score of the other three players.
- 100% of handicap will be used

SEPT 1 - LOW NET (LAST EVENT FOR POY)

- Scoring will be on a net basis
- 100% of handicap will be used

SEPT 8 - TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS

- Weekly winners are eligible to compete in a low gross, low net format. This year the event will be held at the TBD.

SEASON LONG MATCH PLAY TOURNAMENT

Entry Deadline: The first 16 paid entries.

Entry Fee: \$10

Prizes: Gift certificates to the top four finishers

Format: Match Play at 100% home course handicap, single elimination
Each match must be completed within the prescribed time frame.
Any matches not completed will be decided by a coin flip!!!

Rules: USGA match play rules will be in effect. The following local rules will apply:

- **All matches must be played from the Forward (red) tees.**
- Players may play a nine-hole match if both players agree.
- Players may agree to match scorecards if not playing together; however there must be at least two other players to attest the score.
- Matches must use the most current handicap revision available for each player.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- During most events this season, prize money in the form of pro shop credit, will be awarded according to your finish position during each week's event. Money will accumulate throughout the season with the player of the year award going to the player who accumulates the most money during the season. The money total should represent the player who played consistently well and who played in the majority of the events during the season. Prize money is always in the form of pro shop merchandise credit.



RULES AND ETIQUETTE

- Events will be held on Tuesdays and you must tee off during the block of times reserved for Women's club.

- **Tee time requests will be accepted one week in advance. Requests can be made for time periods between; 10-11 or 11-12. The golf operations staff will conduct a lottery and issue tee times on the Thursday prior to the next event. You may or may not be assigned a tee time within your requested block based on demand and past tee time allocation. You may sign-up for the weekly event through Sunday night.**
- **If you must cancel, please do so at the earliest possible time.**
- **Tee times must be observed. Please show up at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time.**

- **Slow play will not be tolerated.** You must keep pace with the group in front of you. Be ready to play with club in hand when it is your turn.
- **Handicaps must be established. You must post every score whether you play at home or away.**
- Replace divots, repair ball marks, and rake the sand to a smooth surface. Leave the course in the condition you would like to play from.
- All USGA rules govern play, except where modified by local rules. A “Ladies’ Provisional” is allowed for balls hit into areas marked as water hazards.
- For all play at the Breckenridge Golf Club, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.

LIGHTNING PROCEDURES

- USGA rule 6-8a authorizes a player to discontinue play if he or she considers that there is danger from lightning. This is one of the rare occasions on which the player is virtually the final judge. The safety of the players is paramount, especially as there is a natural fear of lightning. Please take necessary precautions such as finding one of the weather shelters on the golf course. The maintenance building and clubhouse should also be utilized.
