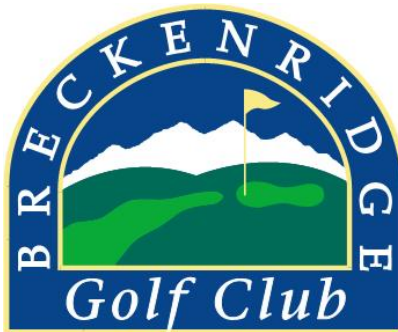

# WOMEN'S CLUB – 2026 OVERVIEW

The Breckenridge Women's Club is an organization that allows golfers to play in a competitive and fun environment. The Club events are held on Tuesdays, from June 2<sup>nd</sup> through September 8<sup>th</sup>.

- The Women's Club schedule is comprised of different events including individual, two person, and four person team events. The goal each year is to create a competitive, equitable, and enjoyable club. Each year we add/delete events to keep the schedule fresh. **Tee time requests will be accepted one week in advance. Requests can be made for time periods between; 8:00-9:30, or 9:30-11:00. The golf operations staff will conduct a lottery and issue tee times on the Saturday prior to the next event. You may or may not be assigned a tee time within your requested block based on demand and past tee time allocation. You may sign up for the weekly event through Sunday night, although you are not guaranteed a spot.**
- Ladies Club members are able to choose their teams and pairings to allow players to play with friends. If you are a member that does not have a team or a group to play with, our staff will help you find a good pairing. We hope all members will be open to playing with new players throughout the year. Staff will set up pairings for Club Championship and certain events TBD.

## 2026 WOMEN'S CLUB SCHEDULE

- 2026 dues are \$150 which includes USGA Handicap
- *In the spirit of the game, please read and use the rules as they are written. Please educate your fellow golfers to proper rulings and pace of play. **Failure to know and understand the rules will result in disqualification.***
- There is a \$10 weekly entry fee for each event.
- Prize money is issued in the form of shop credit for pro shop merchandise.
- Green fees are required for weekly play.

## 2026 EVENT FORMATS

### **JUNE 2 – STEP ASIDE SCRAMBLE (SHOTGUN START)**

- Four-person event
- All four players tee off and play off the best ball.
- The person's ball that is chosen must "step aside" and is not allowed to hit the next shot.
- Continue until the ball is on the green, all four players will putt.
- 25% Player A, 20% Player B, 15% Player C, 10% Player D

### **JUNE 9 – HATE EM'**

- Individual event
- Before teeing off, CIRCLE on your card the 3 holes you hate the most.
- When adding your score, do not add the 3 holes you circled.
- Prizes will be awarded to overall Gross and Net winners
- 100% Handicapped

### **JUNE 16 – TEAM BALL SCRAMBLE**

- Four-person event
- Each Team is handed a sleeve (3) of marked balls prior to the round.
- A player must be playing a marked ball on each hole. Players must rotate in order who plays the marked ball throughout the round.
- If the team loses all three balls throughout the round, their scorecard will not count towards the event.
- 25% Player A, 20% Player B, 15% Player C, 10% Player D

### **JUNE 23 – KISS MY PUTT**

- Two-person event
- Keep track of your team's total putts. Teams with the least putts win!
- A player who picks up due to a max score will write down three (3) putts.

### **JUNE 30 – GUESS YOUR SCORE**

- Individual event
- On the first tee, guess your score and record it with the Professional Staff.
- The player who guesses their score or is closest to it win!

### **JULY 7 – ODDS & EVENS**

- Four-person event
- 1 best net ball will be counted on the odd numbered holes, and 2 best net balls will be counted on the even numbered holes.
- 75% of handicap will be used.

### **JULY 14 – TEXAS SCRAMBLE (SHOTGUN START)**

- Four person teams
- All players tee off and play off the best ball for the entirety of the hole.
- A minimum of four drives must be used per player.
- 25% Player A, 20% Player B, 15% Player C, 10% Player D

**JULY 21 – BETTER BALL OF PARTNER – THREE STRIKES**

- Two person teams. Handicaps are applied on the appropriate holes. The team will have one net better ball recorded as a team score on each hole.
- A team's three worst scores will be removed from their total
- 75% of handicap will be used

**JULY 28 – THREE, TWO, ONE**

- A four-person team will count three net best balls on the par threes, two best net balls on the par fours and one best net ball on the par fives.
- Blind players will be added to teams of three (3)

**AUG 4 – CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**

- To be eligible you must have played in at least two regular season events or been a member in 2025.
- This year's Club Championship is an 18-hole event.
- Gross and Net Division
- Trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishers in each division.

**AUG 11 – THREE STRIKES**

- Individual event.
- After your round, your three worst scores will be removed from your total.
- Prizes will be awarded to overall Gross and Net winners
- 100% of handicap will be used.

**AUG 18 – BETTER BALL OF BLIND PARTNER**

- Staff will assign partners after everyone has teed off.
- One best net ball will count for the team score.
- 100% of handicap will be used.

**AUG 25 – TEAM STABLEFORD – SCRAMBLE**

- Four person teams
- All players tee off and play off the best ball for the entirety of the hole.
- 25% Player A, 20% Player B, 15% Player C, 10% Player D

<b>DOUBLE EAGLE = 5</b>	<b>EAGLE = 4</b>
<b>BIRDIE = 3</b>	<b>PAR = 2</b>
<b>BOGEY = 1</b>	<b>DOUBLE BOGEY OR MORE = 0</b>

**SEPT 1 – LOW NET – TAX EXEMPT**

- Scoring will be on a net basis.
- 100% of handicap will be used.
- A players four (4) worst scores will be removed from their total

**SEPT 8 – END OF SEASON PARTY – SCRAMBLE – TAX EXEMPT**

- Four person teams
- All players tee off and play off the best ball for the entirety of the hole.
- A minimum of four drives must be used per player.
- 25% Player A, 20% Player B, 15% Player C, 10% Player D
- A team's four (4) worst scores will be removed from their total

## PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- During most events this season, prize money in the form of pro shop credit will be awarded according to your finish position during each week's event. Money will accumulate throughout the season with the player of the year award going to the player who accumulates the most money during the season. The money total should represent the player who played consistently well and who played in the majority of the events during the season. Prize money is always in the form of pro shop merchandise credit.
- A reminder that all pro shop credit must be used in the current season. Shop credit will no longer carry over year to year.



## RULES AND ETIQUETTE

- Events will be held on Tuesdays, and you must tee off during the block of times reserved for women's club (a maximum of 52 spots per week)

- Tee time requests will be accepted one week in advance. Requests can be made for time periods between; 8:00-9:30, and 9:30-11:00. The golf operations staff will conduct a lottery and issue tee times on the Saturday prior to the next event. You may or may not be assigned a tee time within your requested block based on demand and past tee time allocation. You may sign-up for the weekly event through **Sunday** night, although you are not guaranteed a time.
- If you must cancel, please give staff a **minimum of 48 hours' notice**. Failure to give proper notice will result in disqualification from future events.
- Tee times must be observed. Please show up a **MINIMUM** of 15 minutes before your scheduled time. Failure to show up on time will result in disqualification from league.

- **Slow play will not be tolerated.** You must keep pace with the group in front of you. Be ready to play with club in hand when it is your turn. **Rounds should be completed in no more than 4 ½ hours.** If you are not keeping up with the group in front of you your group is behind. **Failure to keep pace will result in 2 warnings followed by disqualification from league.**
- Handicaps must be established to compete in league. **You must post every score** whether you play at home or away. Those without GHIN will need to post a minimum of five current scores (last 12 months) before they are eligible for league play. **Violations will result in disqualification from league at the discretion of the Golf & Nordic Manager, Golf & Nordic Coordinator, and Head Professional.**
- Replace divots, repair ball marks, and rake the sand to a smooth surface. Leave the course in better condition than you found it.
- All USGA rules govern play, except where modified by local rules. A "Ladies provisional" is allowed for balls hit into areas marked as water hazards.
- For all league play at the Breckenridge Golf Club, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only, **NO SLOPE ADJUSTMENTS ALLOWED.**

## LIGHTNING PROCEDURES

- USGA rule 6-8a authorizes a player to discontinue play if he or she considers that there is danger from lightning. The safety of the players is paramount, especially as there is a natural fear of lightning. Please take necessary precautions such as finding one of the weather shelters on the golf course. The maintenance building, starter shed, and clubhouse should also be utilized.

## HANDICAP PROCEDURES AND SCORE POSTING

- World Handicap System- With the daily update occurring with the new handicap system, Breckenridge Golf Club will use indexes from the Sunday prior to each event.
- Each player is responsible for posting his or her own score in the handicap computer or by using the GHIN mobile app. Golf shop staff WILL NOT post players scores.
- Always adjust your scores with new maximum score rule.

- **Maximum Score-** The maximum hole score for each player will be limited to a Net Double Bogey.

- Par + 2 + any handicap strokes you receive = Max Score
- Example: Joe- Course Handicap of 20

Hardest Hole- #1 Handicap Hole	Par 4
Double Bogey	+ 2
Strokes on Hole	+ 2
<b>Maximum Score</b>	<b>8 = Max Score for Hole</b>

- **When posting scores to GHIN we recommend posting either “Hole-by-Hole” or “Hole-by-Hole with Stats”. This will automatically adjust to your maximum score.**
- Handicaps will update daily for 2026.
